### Cookies Policy

Our websites use cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site. By continuing to browse the site or by clicking 'I accept', you are agreeing to our use of cookies.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

The only cookies utilised on the Celebration websites will be those for Google Analytics and it's related services (to track user actions/events and analyse web traffic), and in some cases a session cookie to identify returning users.

No personally identifiable information is stored directly in cookies. We collect information through cookies with the aim of ensuring the content of the website and the website pathways work as effectively as possible.

By using our website, you agree to us placing the cookies specified above on your device (phone, android, computer, mac etc.).

Please note that third parties (including, for example, advertising networks and providers of external services like web traffic analysis services) may also use cookies, over which we have no control. These cookies are likely to be analytical/performance cookies or targeting cookies.

### How do I turn cookies off?

If you want to delete cookies that are already on your device you can do this by deleting your browser history. You can also block cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of our websites.

We may change this Policy from time to time as a result of changes required for operational or administrative reasons or in order to comply with changes in the law.
